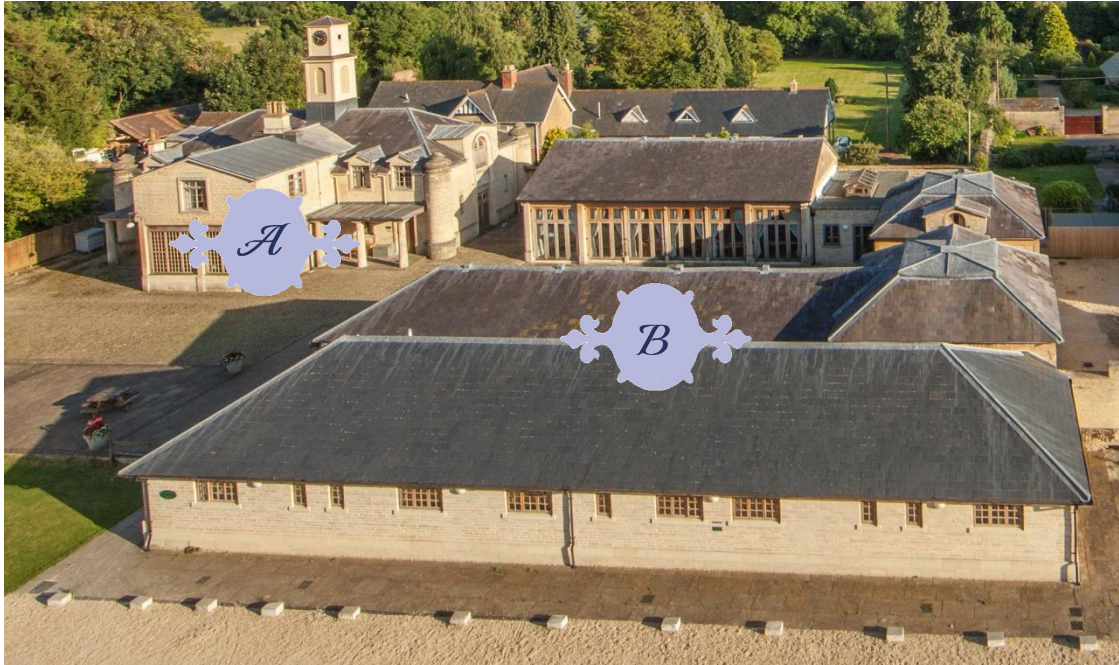




The Stables Overview

The Clock Tower

All 7 bedrooms are on the first floor and are accessed by two staircases, please note the stairs are quite steep with some turns, if your guests are more mature or have difficulty with stairs you may like to allocate them in a room in the Mews, where most of the rooms are on ground floor. Other points to note; room 2 is often used by the bride and groom and has first floor views of the grounds and the House. Rooms 5, 6 and 7 are beautiful beamed rooms with sky lights.

The Mews

12 of the 13 rooms are located on the ground floor. Where possible we have kept original features to maintain the charm. To this end, rooms 10 – 13 are beautifully converted original stables, but please note there are no opening windows. Room 14 has a bathroom suitable for disabled users. Room 16 is the only room that is on the first floor in this building and is set up with four single beds.
